Mobile Phone Policy

Kilgraston Summer School wants to give all our students the very best experience when they are here with us. Therefore, we control the use of mobile phones and other electronic devices to make sure that students are joining in all activities as much as possible. We have found that many text messages and phone calls during the day to and from home can make students feel more homesick, and we want all students to be as happy and as relaxed as possible during their stay with us. This is why we allow/don't allow students to use mobile phones and devices at the following times:

- All students must leave mobile phones and other devices with residential staff before going to their morning classes.
- All students can have electronic devices from after lunch until the start of activities, after which they should return them to residential staff.*
- Following afternoon activities, students can have devices. They must return these to activity leaders before the start of the evening social programme.
- After evening activities, students have the opportunity to use their phones until bedtime.
- From bedtime until morning assembly the next day, all students must hand in their phones to residential staff.
- Students may have their devices over weekends, but on Sunday night they should be given back to staff.

*For Wednesday afternoon excursions, students may take their phones and other devices with them in order to take photos. Students have full responsibility for their devices on excursions.

Parents have the opportunity to opt out of this if they wish, but must do so in writing before their child's arrival.
